As you may know, GenOn Energy, Inc. and certain of their directly and indirectly owned subsidiaries ("GenOn") filed voluntary petitions for reorganization under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code in June 2017. On December 12, 2017, the GenOn Third Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization was approved by the bankruptcy court setting the path for GenOn's separation from NRG Energy, Inc. by June 2018, with possible extensions. After GenOn emerges from bankruptcy, they will no longer be covered by your master supply agreement with NRG.

NRG understands that GenOn may seek to renegotiate your current NRG agreement to become effective as part of a new GenOn agreement to facilitate their separation. In order to avoid any confusion, NRG wants to assure you that any action taken by GenOn is independent of NRG and will not affect your existing agreement and pricing with NRG, which will continue in accordance with existing terms.
