Boston's Building Emissions Reduction and Disclosure Ordinance (BERDO) is entering a new phase.

The focus is now on what's next: future requirements and potential costs. Even as the national landscape shifts, BERDO remains in effect for covered buildings in Boston. Reporting continues and emissions standards tighten over time.

Planning ahead helps you stay compliant with confidence and better manage future costs.

How it works

BERDO applies to all commercial and residential buildings in Boston over 20,000 square feet.

Covered building owners must:

- ✓ Report annual energy and water use
- ✓ Meet emissions performance standards
- ✓ Address emissions that exceed established thresholds

Penalties are tied to emissions performance. For many buildings, using a renewable energy solution can be a more cost-effective way to address electricity related emissions than paying Alternative Compliance Payments.
